Challenges in Intensive Care





up to 350

daily alarms per ICU bed, of which 90% are clinically irrelevant and 50% are not even noticed.⁹

10 %

of ICU patients develop ARDS with a mortality of 30-40 %, often initiated by ventilation

only 41%

of the patients who are artificially ventilated for at least 14 days, will survive the next year.⁷

43.7%

of ICU patients suffer from delirium in the UK this increases length of stay and has long term impact on the patient's mental health
