NOTES ON THE OUTLINE CURRICULA FOR LEADING TO THE AWARD OF A CERTIFICATE IN CLINICAL STUDIES

Note: Where the title of the course states that it is for Registered and/or Enrolled nurses this means that the course is open to nurses whose names are entered on any part of the Register of the United Kingdom Central Council for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting.

Course 100 General Intensive Care Nursing for Registered General Nurses and Registered Sick Children's Nurses	£1.15
<p>The length of this course is 24–27 weeks exclusive of any holidays taken during the course. It is recommended that the nurse should have a minimum of six months' experience as a Staff Nurse (not necessarily in the specialty) before taking the course.</p>	
Course 155 General Intensive Care Nursing for Enrolled Nurses (General)	£1.15
<p>The length of this course is 24–27 weeks exclusive of any holidays taken during the course. It is recommended that the nurse should have four weeks' experience in an Intensive Care Unit before taking the course.</p>	
Course 124 Coronary Care Nursing for Registered General Nurses	£0.85
<p>The length of this course is 17–19 weeks exclusive of any holidays taken during the course. For nurses who have completed an approved course in General Intensive Care the length of the course is 12–13 weeks exclusive of any holidays taken during the course. Health Authorities may not use the same unit for both a full length and a shortened course.</p>	

Course 906

Short Course in Nursing for Gastro-Intestinal Endoscopy and related procedures for Registered General Nurses and Enrolled Nurses (General)

£0.85

This is a 10–12 days course mainly for nurses who are working or going to work in gastro-intestinal investigation units. It may be planned on a block or day release basis or a combination of both. The outline curriculum has been developed for two groups of nurses:

- (i) Registered General Nurses with one year's post basic general experience.
- (ii) Enrolled Nurses (General) with one year's post basic general experience.

As the needs and expectations of these two groups are different, a separate course will be required for each group. Therefore, the outline curriculum will need to be adapted accordingly.

Course 910

Short Course on the Principles of Infection Control for Registered General Nurses

£0.85

This is a 10–15 day course for infection control nurses who have been working in this capacity for at least one year. Part or all of the course may be planned on a day-release basis.

Course 913

Short Course on the Care and Rehabilitation of Physically Disabled People for Registered Midwives, Registered General Nurses, Registered Sick Children's Nurses, Registered Mental Nurses, Registered Nurses for the Mentally Handicapped and Enrolled Nurses

£0.85

This is a 20 day course for nurses and midwives from any work situation in the hospital or in the community. The course will assist nurses and midwives to further their knowledge and understanding of the needs and problems of physically disabled people within their own field or practice, and how to help each person cope with his/her disability, achieve maximum independence, the best possible quality of life and reach full potential.

Course 918

Short Course on the Principles of Intensive Care for Enrolled Nurses

£0.85

This is a 15 day course for Enrolled Nurses with a minimum of two years experience in intensive care nursing. It is designed to teach new developments and update and refresh skills and knowledge of the specialty. It may be planned on a block or day release basis or a combination of both.
