This will bring Northern Ireland into line with the rest of the home nations.  There is of SNOD education planned regarding deemed consent.  Region reports, mention of recruitment issues in the London region.  Mention of Organ Donation money available for critical care nurses' wellbeing.  Discussion regarding the 'Donations actions framework', requesting confirmation of endorsement from stakeholders. This is presently with the national boards PAs.
